INTRODUCTION

Social impact

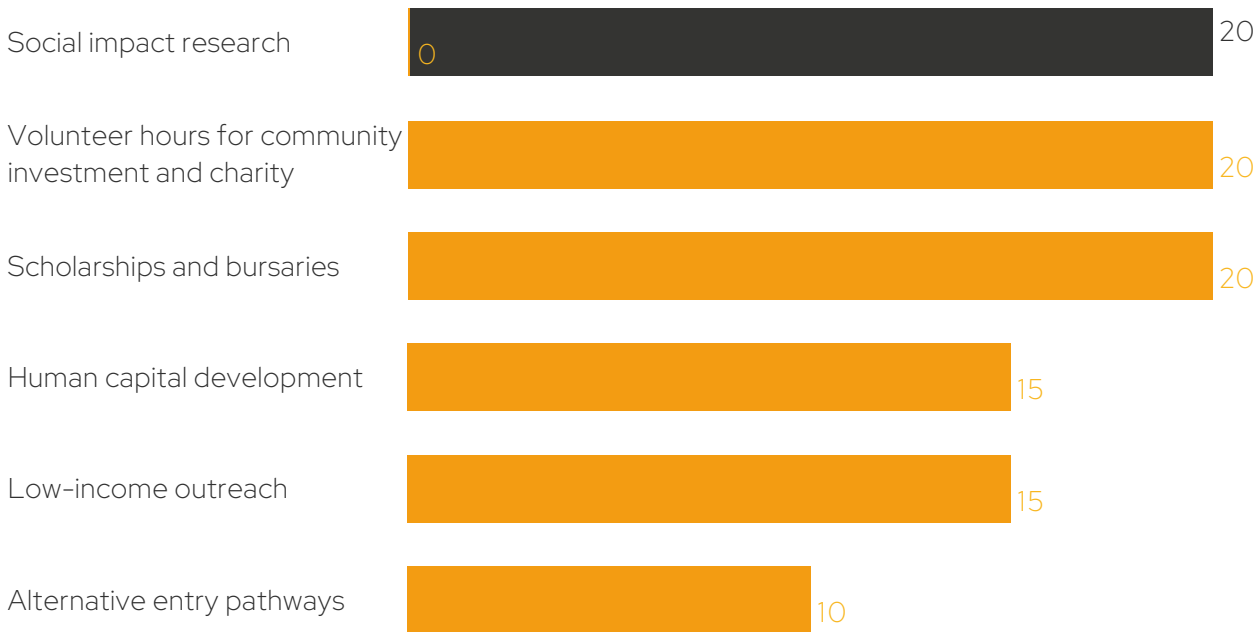

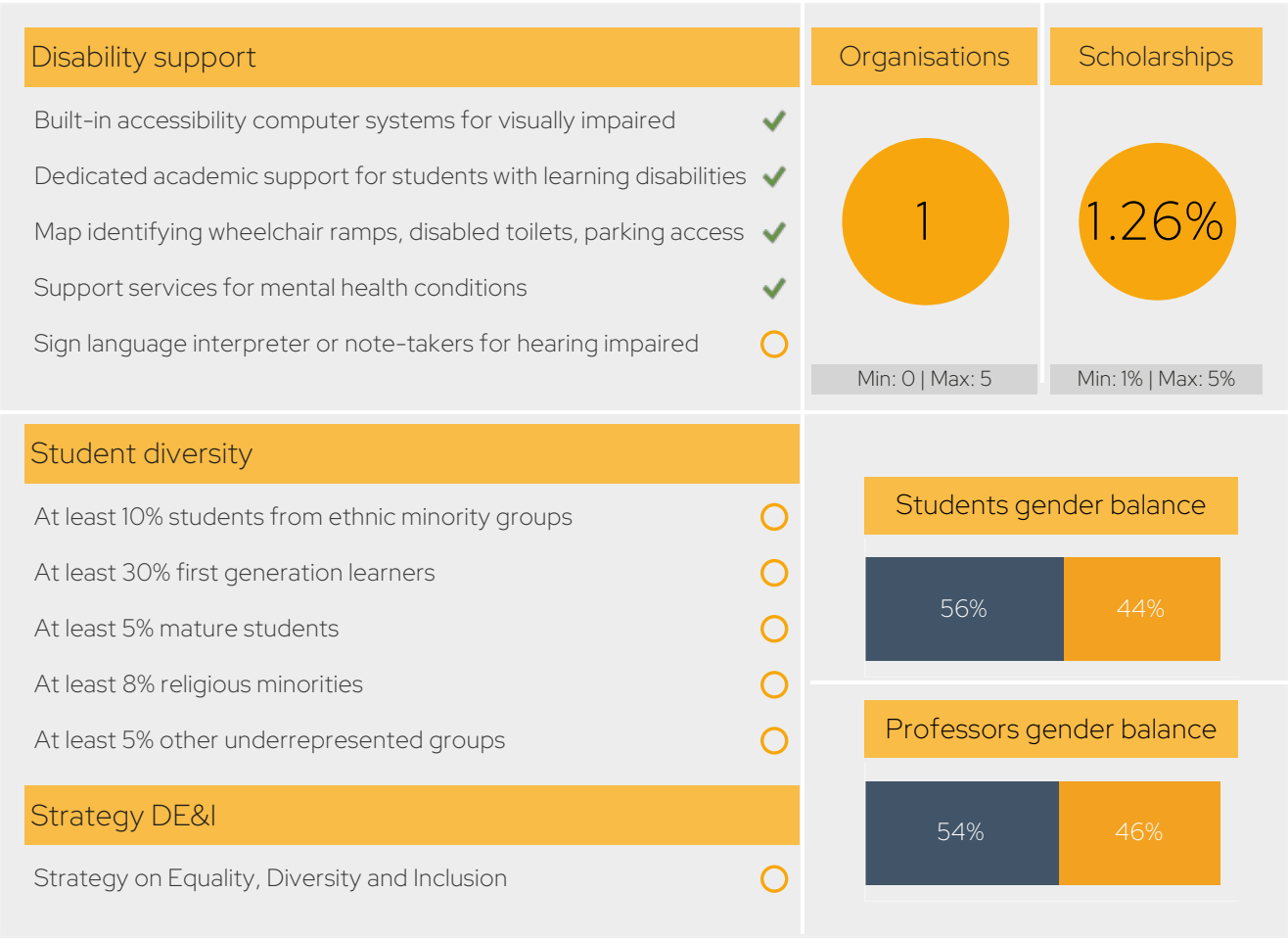

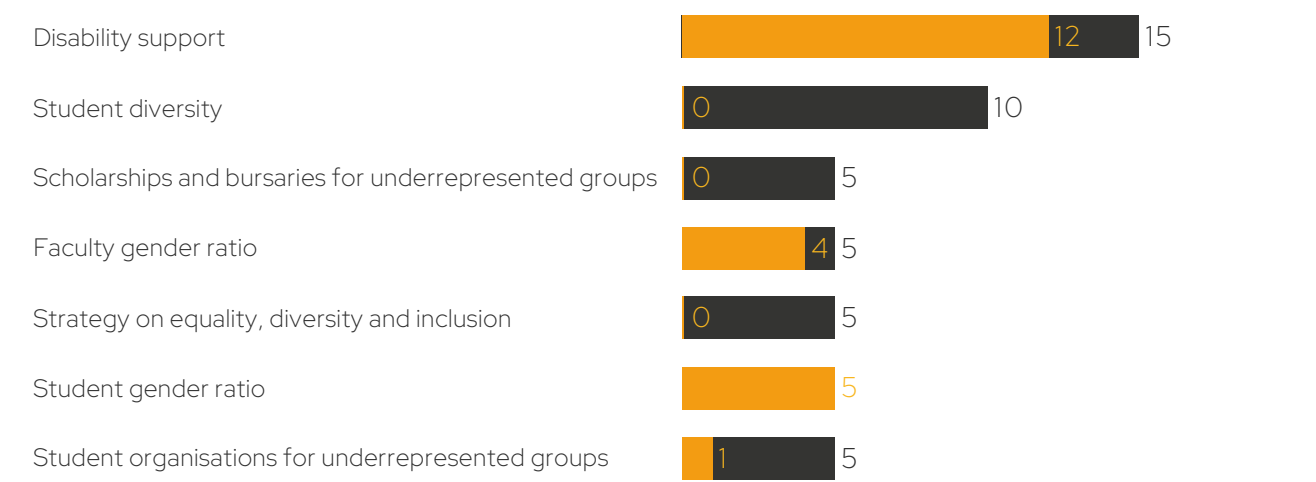
Diversity, equity & inclusion

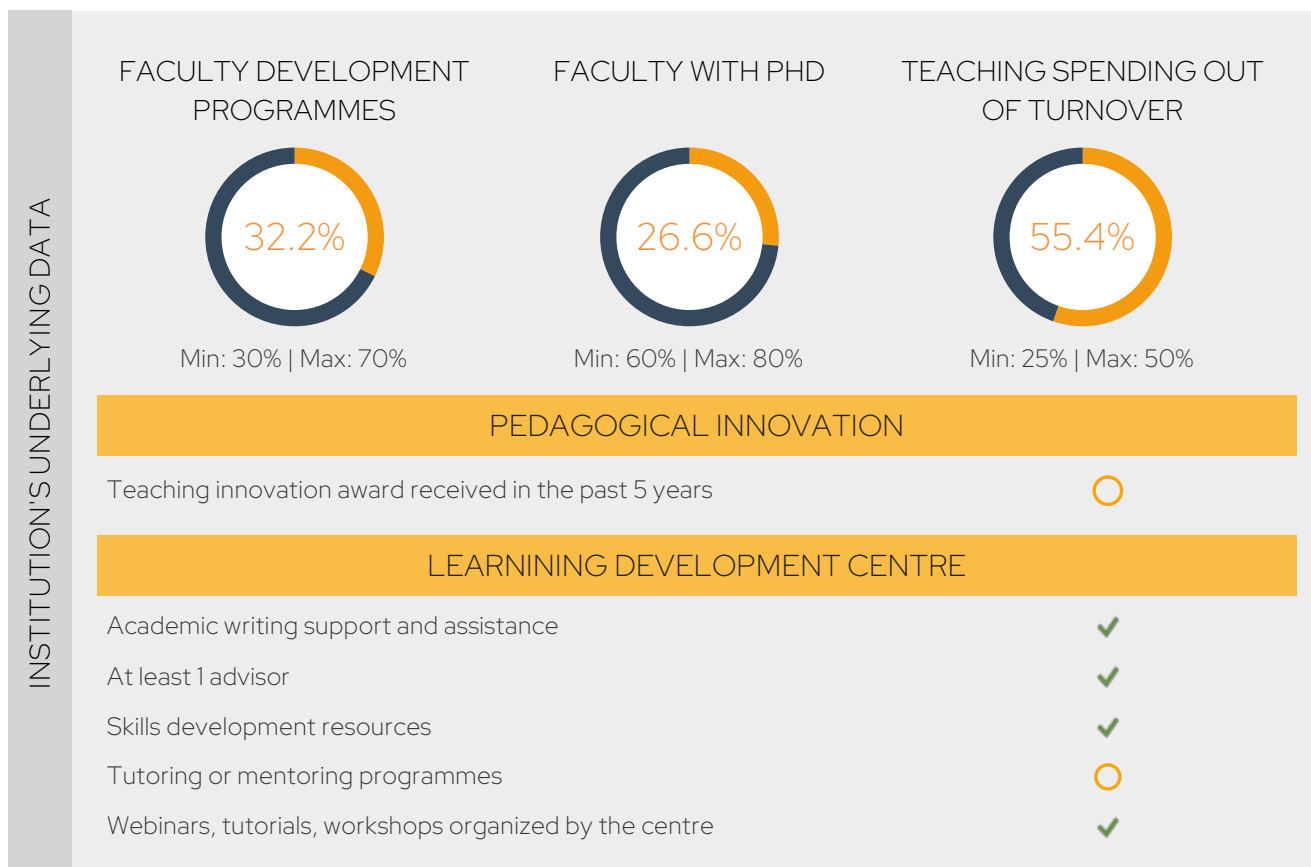

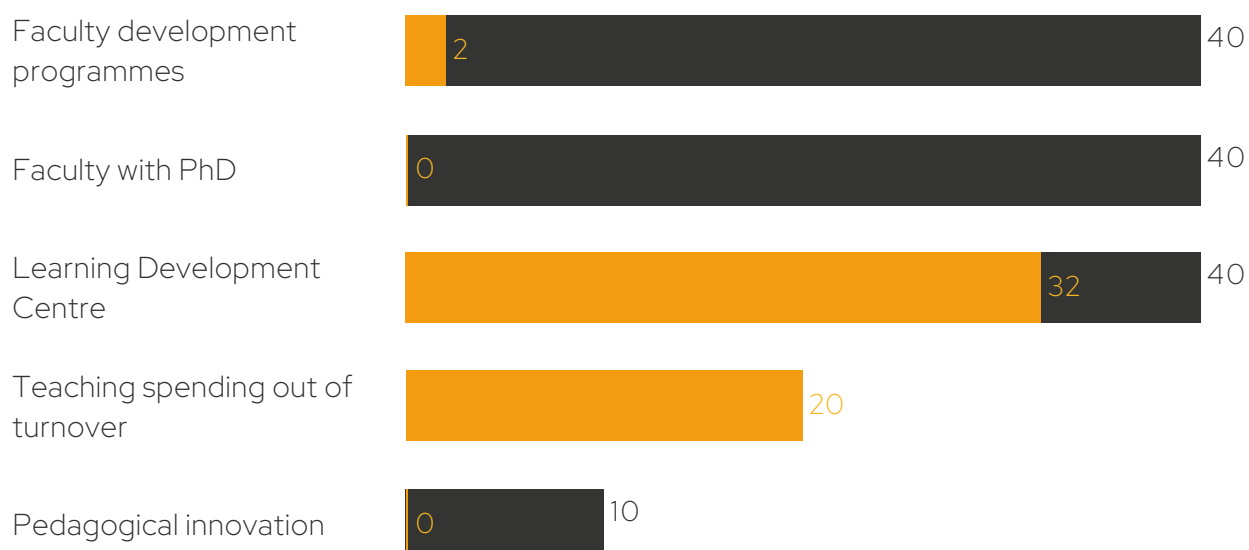


Academic development

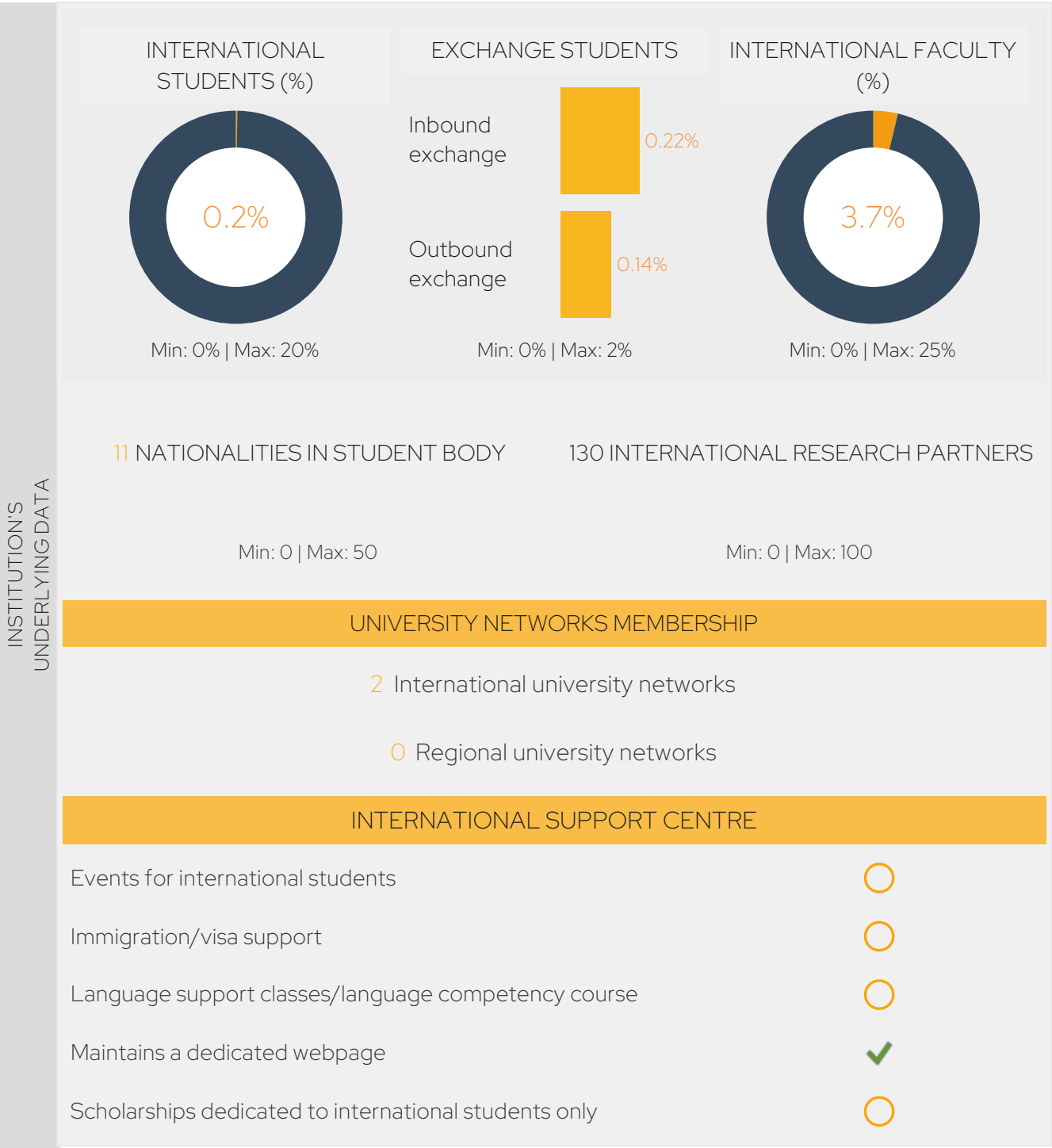


Global engagement
